Why support Mercy Community Healthcare?

Mercy provides affordable, quality care for the community. Mercy is a safety net for low-income individuals and families. The cost per visit for someone without insurance at Mercy is \$125, which includes medical or mental healthcare. Mercy offers financial aid based on household income and size. Mercy raises the gap between the amount the patient pays and the actual cost of their care through donors, like you!



Facts about Mercy Community Healthcare:

- Approximately 14,500 patients call Mercy Community Healthcare their medical home.
- Mercy Community Healthcare offers services for Pediatric Primary Care, Adult Primary Care, Gynecology, Mental healthcare and Patient and Family Support. This program connects patients to discounted specialist appointments, navigation to Medicare, Medicaid and marketplace insurance as well as basic needs like food, housing so there are no barriers to care.
- Approximately 51% of Mercy's visits are mental health.
- 55% of Mercy Community Healthcare's patients are uninsured, on TennCare (Medicaid) or Medicare.

- Financial aid is available for patients without insurance based on household size and income.
- Mercy Community Healthcare is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization in Franklin, TN.
